Uncle Louies is trying to start up a Sundance Summer Nights – possibly the 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday in June, July & August. Make it family event with music, actives, encourage businesses to be open where people shopped while they were at the event. Andy mentioned there are production companies that help handle the band portion and things like that and it was expensive. She will continue to investigate things to see if it would work in our community. The chamber would help support the event with promotion and any advice they can help with.

### Old Business:

Movies in the Park – Movies are all sold, and things are moving forward. Concessions and special events are lined up.

Country Junkin – forms and signs are being ordered. Hulett Chamber is being revived and would like to be involved but can't financially support it this year. They are willing to help by adding the event to their website and support in promotion. We will include them on the flyer.

Billboard – will be up in May, it's on the interstate around Piedmont headed West.
